All participants are required to submit the official registration form together with 5 generations pedigree, confirmation of maximum 3.125% OX, and a copy of the national registration card (licence) of the rider/driver.

Registration forms must be send to our official e-mail address: haflinger2017@centrum.cz, the deadline is **31 May 2017**.

The final deadline for making changes in the registrations is 15 July 2017.

With the exception of gallop races, where the application can be submitted on the spot.

Fees

Registration fee - 2 000 CZK (3 000 CZK for late registration)

The registration fee covers registration and administration costs, and a stall box for the horse (4 days including hay and bedding).

Rules

Admission Procedures

a) Horses

The competitions are open to all European participants.

All horses registered in an official Haflinger studbook, in possession of an officially recognised 5 generations pedigree certificate and with maximum 3.125 % of Arab blood, regardless of height at the withers, are eligible.

There are no qualification rules.

During the event all horses must be stabled only in boxes provided by the organiser and may not leave the event area. No horse may be moved out of the area before the end of the event, under the penalty of exclusion of horse and rider or driver.

Each horse may compete with only one competitor per discipline. Maximum possible combinations of disciplines:

show jumping + dressage + gallop races eventing + gallop races driving + gallop races

Categories of horses by age:

Young horses: 4 and 5 yearsAdult horses: 6 years and older

b) Competitors

- There shall be no breakdown by age or merit. Minimum age for participation is born in 2005 or earlier, there is no maximum age.
- In all classes every participant can compete with maximum three horses or pairs. The organiser is not liable for qualification.
- The rider/driver has to declare a valid national licence for the discipline/s he/she participates in, with the exception of gallop races where participation without the licence is possible.

Participation Conditions and Organisational Information

All participants have to contact the registration office immediately after their arrival at the event area. All horses must pass the veterinary check-up immediately after the arrival.

The registration and veterinary check-up will be available on Thursday 3 August until 6 pm.

Veterinary conditions are posted in a separate attachment.

Early arrival (before 3 August) is possible only by individual permission of the organiser.

The technical meeting for all disciplines will take place on Thursday 3 August at 8 pm and is compulsory for all participants!

The organiser strongly recommends the competitors to have an adequate liability insurance coverage. Each participant is liable for the damage that he himself or his animals cause to third parties, to the material assets of the organiser, and to the owner of the property or the tenant. The participation of each driver/rider is at his own risk and with full liability.

Dogs must be kept on a lead throughout the event area. The owners shall be liable for any damage caused by dogs.

More organisational information will be published in a special attachment and send to all registered participants.

Starting Order

Starting order of each competition will be established by the organiser.

General Rules

Internationally accepted standard FEI rules for equestrian sports with national modifications and internationally accepted standard of animal welfare will be applied.

Special Provisions of the Championship:

- maximum length of the dressage whip (including for training) is 120 cm,
- it is forbidden to use the whip in the dressage part of the eventing competition,
- maximum length of the whip for jumping competitions is 75 cm,
- the spurs shall be soft and cannot exceed the length of 3.5 cm,
- only light and short gaithers on the front and hind legs are allowed (with the exception of dressage competition where the gaithers are forbidden),
- training, cooling down and driving is reserved to participants only, at designated hours and in designated areas,
- upon leaving their box, all horses must carry their number label on their head at all times to allow identification,
- helmets (or hats) are mandatory,
- draw reins are not permitted,
- all horses may be ridden or driven only by the participants, during the whole event and anywhere in the area.
- poling and all methods aimed at causing the horse to jump higher and/or with increased care are not permitted anywhere in the area for the duration of whole event.

In case on non-compliance, the horse and participant shall be disqualified immediately.

Dressage tests are all ridden by heart.

Judgement from three points.

Evaluation: Overall standings are determined by adding the results of both rounds.

SHOW JUMPING

Two-round competition with finals

Evaluation: Rules for Jumping Events by FEI + national modifications

1st round will be evaluated by penalty points on obstacles.

2nd round will be evaluated by penalty points on obstacles and time.

The first 25% of those classified from both rounds (adding the penalty points from both rounds and time from the 2nd round) shall be admitted to the finals.

<u>The final result</u> shall take into account the sum of penalties form 1st and 2nd round and the finals and the fastest time obtained in the jump-off.

<u>Partial results of the 1st and 2nd rounds</u> will be judged by the number of penalty points on the obstacles and achieved time.

The starting order for the 2nd round - participants will start in reverse order by the results from the 1st round.

The starting order for the finals - participants will start in reverse order by the results from the both rounds.

The rider who does not complete the first round may start in the second round, but without the right to participate in the finals.

DRIVING - PAIRS

Evaluation:

The 1st and 2nd round is evaluated by time and all penalty points on obstacles will be converted to the seconds.

Speed 250 m/min.

Exceeding the time, which is determined by the length and the speed per minute, is not penalized. Exceeding the allowable time means disqualification for the finals, but the competitor can compete in the 2nd round with a time penalty of double allowable time.

Overall standings are determined by adding the results of both rounds.

The width of the cone obstacles is 180 cm.

Minimum width of the coach is 125 cm (marathon coaches allowed).

Minimum weight of the coach is not determined.

Uniaxial coach is not allowed.

Dress for the rider and groom is allowed to be less formal, helmet is compulsory, safety vest is recommended.
